**Preventing Preschool Fadeout through Instructional ...**

meta-analytic study estimated the magnitude of preschool intervention fadeout at 0.25 standard deviations per post-treatment year (Leak et al, 2013) Little research has focused on why short-term gains from preschool may disappear and the conditions under which gains from preschool might be sustained into elementary school
